Record Status and Arrowhead WA 24 Target mixed. Both days 12 targets unmarked, 12 targets marked distances.
Freestyle, Compound Unlimited, Compound Limited, Compound Barebow, Longbow, Barebow, Traditional DCAS and Exmouth Medals will be awarded in all classes on the following basis – 1 st - 1 Archer, 2 nd - 4 Archers, 3 rd – 7 or more Archers.
 Red: All sighted classes except U15 sighted recurve (Freestyle) Blue: Unsighted classes; U15 sighted recurve (Freestyle) White: All Juniors under 12 and unsighted juniors up to the age of 15. Pink and Green: Non Record Status but can be provided on request.

Entries will only be processed in order of receipt of payment. All refunds will be at the discretion of the Tournament Organiser, but none will be made after the closing date.
