Disposal Of Carbon Damaged Arrows  
The Club is mindful that the disposal of Carbon arrows must be dealt with thoughtfully. We will therefore provide a canister (Drain Pipe tube) at the Clubhouse, once it is filled, it will be sealed and then disposed of appropriately. Please do not put carbon arrows directly in waste bins or skips.

Safety on the Range  
Can we please remind you that it is not permissible to wear open toed sandals and shoes (ie Croc type shoes) etc on the range. This also applies to non shooting visitors to the club if they walk on the range and approach the targets. This is a requirement from the National Governing Body and as such is not negotiable.

Packing away of targets  
It has been noted that some archers are leaving targets on the range at the end of their session instead of putting them away. If someone else on the field wishes to use the target then the packing of it away becomes their responsibility. However, if you have used a boss, please put it away so that the last few members on the field do not have to put away large numbers of bosses that they have not been using.
