Just to keep you up to date on the Indoor Centre, following the SGM: DCAS have agreed a loan of £5,000 to add to the loan of £25,000 offered by GWAS. Contractors have been asked to bring their quotes for the building up to date. Two of the three tenders have been received, the third is awaited, then we can select a contractor and get working on the building regs submission. A surveyor has been on the field to make a detailed topographic survey, which will be used for the foundation and earthworks design, and to define the volume of excavation and what we can do with the excavated material.
