Club Coaches and other members will be happy to continue to help you.

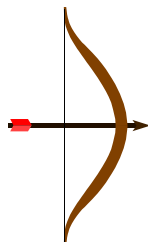
We also have a good social diary including meals, barbecues, outings to pantomimes etc. The committee is always looking for new ideas!

## **About Us**

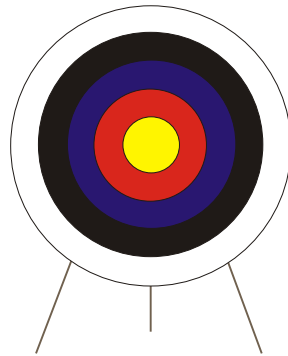
Exmouth Archers is one of the oldest archery clubs in Devon, although with a number of breaks in it's history. The present Club was reformed in 1984.

The Club is well represented at competitive level, but continues to provide a relaxed social atmosphere for intermediate archers and a warm welcome to beginners.

We have an enthusiastic Junior Club, and can accept children from the age of 8.

## **Where can you find us ?**

Exmouth Archers enjoy the facilities at our own grounds, at Withycombe Raleigh Common. This includes a range which can accommodate 28 targets, backed up by a permanent pavilion equipped with a common room, storage and a fully fitted Kitchen. This is mainly used during the 'outdoor season' (May - September). We shoot at the Community College during our 'Indoor Season' (October - April) and at our grounds should the weather be good



## **Who can take part in Archery ?**

Archery caters for all, both male and female, young and old, able bodied and disabled people.

## **I am interested, what should I do next ?**

Before you can shoot you must complete a beginners course, where you will be taught how to shoot - and to shoot safely - by the club Coaches. All equipment will be provided.

Once you have completed the course you can join the Club, where you will continue to receive guidance from the Coaches.

## **What does it cost ?**

The 6 week beginners course costs £45 per person.

Club fees are £108 per year (or £72 per year for Juniors), which is payable by monthly standing order. This allows you to shoot at our grounds at any time.

In addition to this, fees to GNAS, our national body, are due in September of each year. This pays for your insurance among other things and is currently £42 for an adult, cheaper for a Junior.
