Faces:

Faces must be removed from targets please. Please do not stack wet target faces in the Clubhouse. Wet target faces can be put on the tables in the Indoor Centre to dry, only if the target is in a good state. If the target is badly worn, put it in the skip please.

Security:

Please help keep the club secure by keeping the bottom gate locked when you are on the premises. The combination padlock is only to be used on club sessions. IE Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday evenings as well as Sunday mornings. It should not be used at any other time. Please use the normal gate padlock when shooting outside of those times. Remember that the code for the padlock has changed to 1440.

Archery GB Fees:

It's that time of year again when Archery GB fees are due. Please keep an eye open for an email from Chris detailing next years fees, the deadline for paying and account to pay into.

Field Crew Needed:

More help is needed for the set up of the Intercounties Tournament.

Saturday 16th September: set up day - list in the Club House

Sunday 17th September: more hands needed for exciting jobs such as arrow hunting (with metal detectors) and replacing target faces. Plus lots of standing about, sitting down, chatting to other fellow amazing archers, getting tips on shooting technique as well as soaking up the atmosphere of an unmissable GWAS Intercounties Tournament.in the Archery Calendar.

For those of you who have just joined this is an excellent opportunity to see first hand a major competition in all its glory - and be part of the field crew experience.

Monday 28th August: Help is needed. Sign up if you can for the **LAST CAR BOOT of the SEASON**. This is a big fundraising event for our club. These funds go towards target refurbishment, equipment, and hopefully a new shed to store the outdoor targets in. So exciting.



Club Championships: last chance to sign up

This year Exmouth Archers Outdoor Club Championship will be held on **Sunday 3rd September** assembly at 10:30. This is an event for everyone in the club whatever your bow style and level of experience. There will be a picnic after the rounds have been shot. We hope to see as many of you there as possible. Please click the link at the end of this article to enter so we know how many targets we need and numbers for the picnic.

The rounds will be nationals and there will be three distances to choose from; one for juniors under 14 one for older juniors and adults in their first year of archery (novices) and one for experienced adults.

You can choose to shoot whichever round you prefer, but if you choose to shoot a shorter round than indicated by your age and experience you won't be eligible for the awards in that category. Archers who shoot longer rounds than indicated by their age and experience will be eligible for awards in that category.

National rounds consist of 4 dozen at the longer distance and 2 dozen at the shorter distance.

National = 60 yds and 50 yds - Experienced Adult Archers

National 40 = 40 yds and 30 yds - Novice Adult Archers and Juniors over 14

National 30 = 30 yds and 20 yds - Novice Junior Archers and under 14

Target Field: PLEASE SIGN IN with your swipe card for both the indoor centre and the outdoor range. This is important for your insurance and the club's insurance. We must comply with AGB rules that require you to register your attendance on site. Snap checks on card swiping will take place over the next few weeks to monitor that we are all registering our attendance.

Woods: Sign the signing-in book on the right hand side of the shed door. You can't miss it and are not insured to shoot if you do not sign in. **Clean up in the kitchen:** Thank you for caring. it's still looking good in there
